Dear Parents/Guardians,

The Mount Pleasant Area School District manages student grades, homework assignments, attendance, tests and much more through eSchool Plus's **Home Access Center**. All parents have the ability to check their child's information from any device, whether at home or mobile. You are encouraged to visit <https://eschool.mpasd.net/HomeAccess/> using any web browser, or by downloading the "eSchoolPLUS Family" app via the Google Play Store for Android devices; or via the App Store for Apple IOS devices. Further directions for the setup and use of this app can be found within the User Guide available under the Home Access Center tab on the district's website ([www.mpasd.net](http://www.mpasd.net)).

To gain access to the Home Access Center, the system will use information you provided to the school on the emergency cards with your name, address and email address. If you did not supply us with this information and need to do so, be certain to contact the main office of the school your child attends.

To register an account with the Home Access Center, proceed as follows:

1. Log on to <https://eschool.mpasd.net/HomeAccess/> (*Please note that the registration process cannot be done with the app*).
2. Press the button labeled "**Click Here to Register for HAC**"
3. Enter your First Name, Last Name, City (Do not use abbreviations) and Zip Code when prompted (*Information here must match as it was written on the emergency cards*) then press the "**Register**" button. (Do not enter your child's info here...enter your info)
4. Enter a username and two security question answers when prompted.
5. The system will send a link to the email you have on file.
6. The link will direct you to the Home Access Center, prompt you to enter your security answers, then request you to enter a new password.

You will undoubtedly find the Home Access Center a tremendous way to stay in touch with the school and current with your child's academic progress.
